# Using SQL-Server with vMedia

- Image Master & DBF Files
  - DBF Limits
  - Data integrity
  - Compliance risks
- vMedia & SQL Server Databases
  - SQL Server Standard Edition
- SQL Server & vMedia 3.x
  - SQL Server service accounts
  - New features are SQL Server only
  - vAdmin
  - UserTrack
- vMedia & Q-LawE
  - Tightly integrated
  - AMR
  - DOCID





# Image-Master & DBF Files

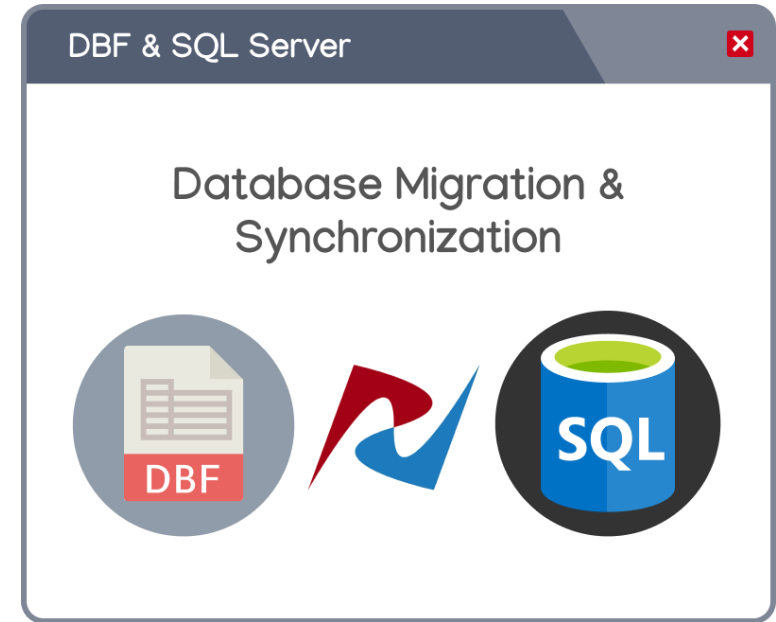
- Last release Image-Master 7 – 2015
- Media Metadata stored in DBF Files
  - 2GB hard limit
  - Field and record size limits
  - Opened in “Distributed Mode”
    - SMB 2 & 3 put DBF Files at risk
    - End Task, crashing, rebooting put data at risk
    - DBF Files may be viewed outside of vMedia
- Unencrypted files available to end users





# vMedia & SQL-Server Databases

- vMedia 1.0 release in 10/2015
- Legacy compatibility / DBF Files
- Migration tool to SQL-Server databases
  - Database limits defined by SQL-Server
  - Much larger field & record size limits
  - Opened in “Client Server”
    - Data integrity assured even with system failure
    - Improved backup capabilities
    - Data is protected by SQL-Server
  - Enterprise support ensures scalability



# SQL-Server Service Accounts

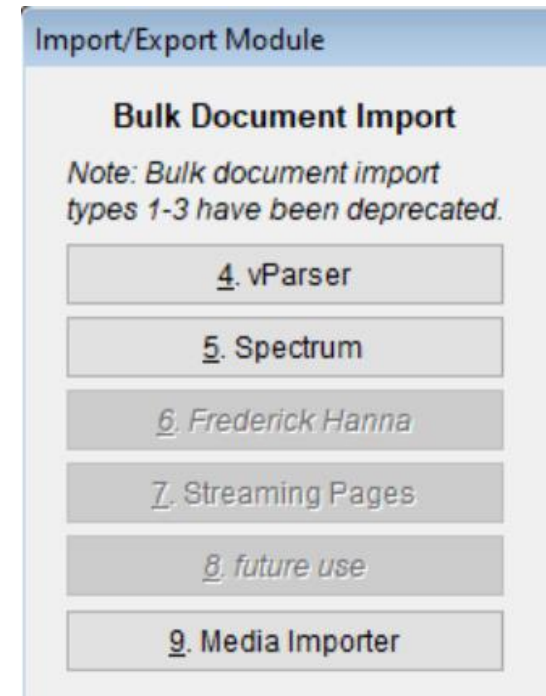


- Traditionally, every user required Windows rights to the vMedia database
  - Users had the ability to connect to SQL-Server and view/modify info
- SQL-Server “Service Account”
  - Single SQL-Server User
  - Provided rights to “Database” (SQL Table)
  - Users do not need to have access to the SQL-Server database
  - Specific changes to configuration and SQL-Server right required to change

# New Features are SQL-Server Only



- Migrate to SQL-Server as soon as convenient
- Switching is compelling
- Legacy Importers have been depreciated
  - Replaced by Spectrum Importer
  - If you are still using a Legacy Importer, it's time to switch to Spectrum





# Full Integration with Q-LawE

- Leverage both vMedia & Q-LawE features
- Q-LawE – Scandoc
  - Q-LawE stores metadata here
  - vMedia will share the same metadata & documents
  - Scan / add media through either product
  - Search / view media through either product
- SQL-Server Options
  - Use view instead of table
  - Disable SQL Index Verification
  - Windows authentication
  - QLAW Connection – Indicator that Q-LawE is connected

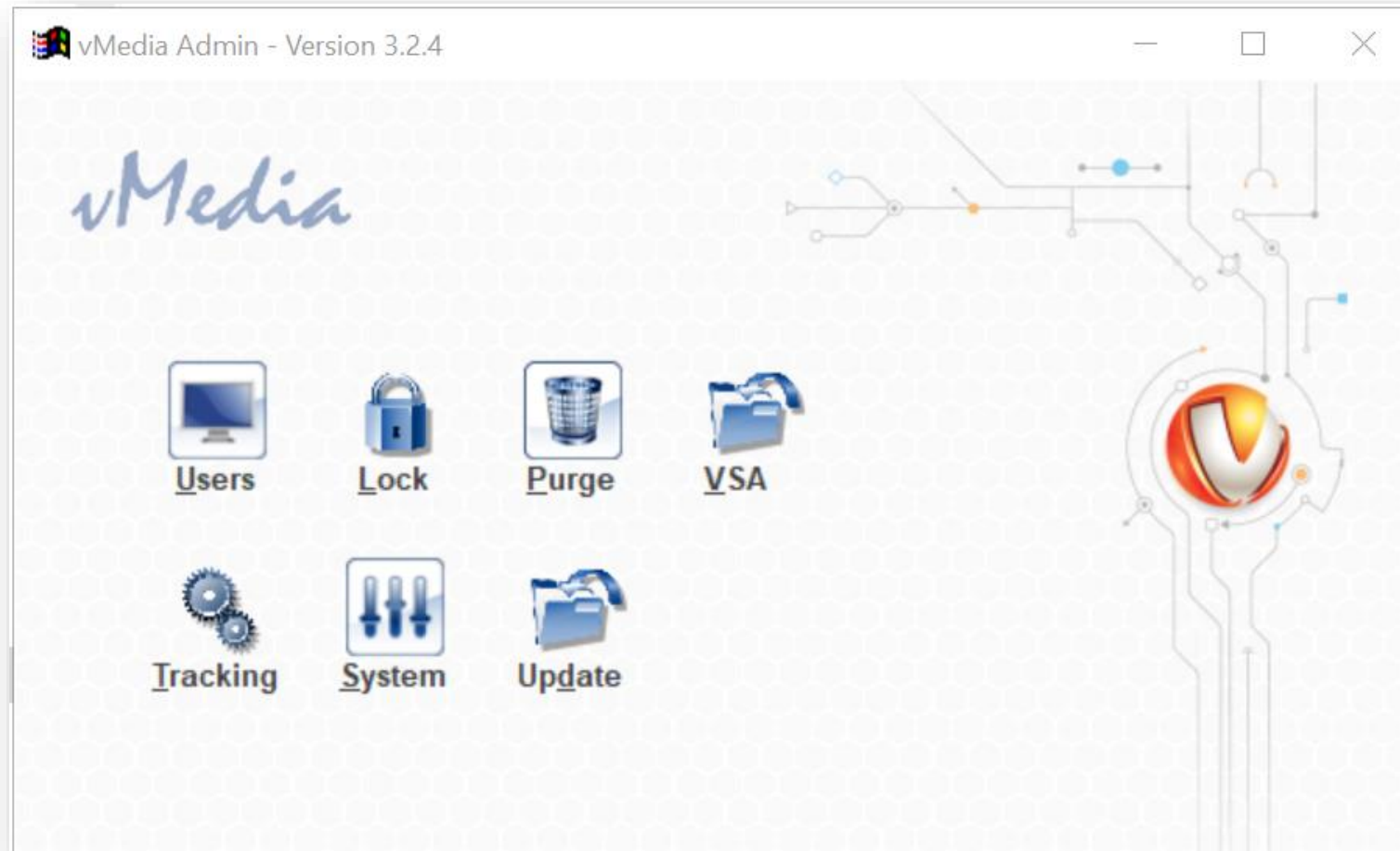
# vAdmin.exe

- Users
  - List Active Users in vMedia
- Lock
  - Force users to exit vMedia
    - Schedule in Advance!
- Purge
  - Purge Usage Log File
- VSA
  - Define the location for VSA – point to Collection-Master or Q-LawE
- Tracking / System
  - User Tracking options
- Update
  - When appropriate, update SQL-Server stored procedures
    - Currently Version 1.2.1

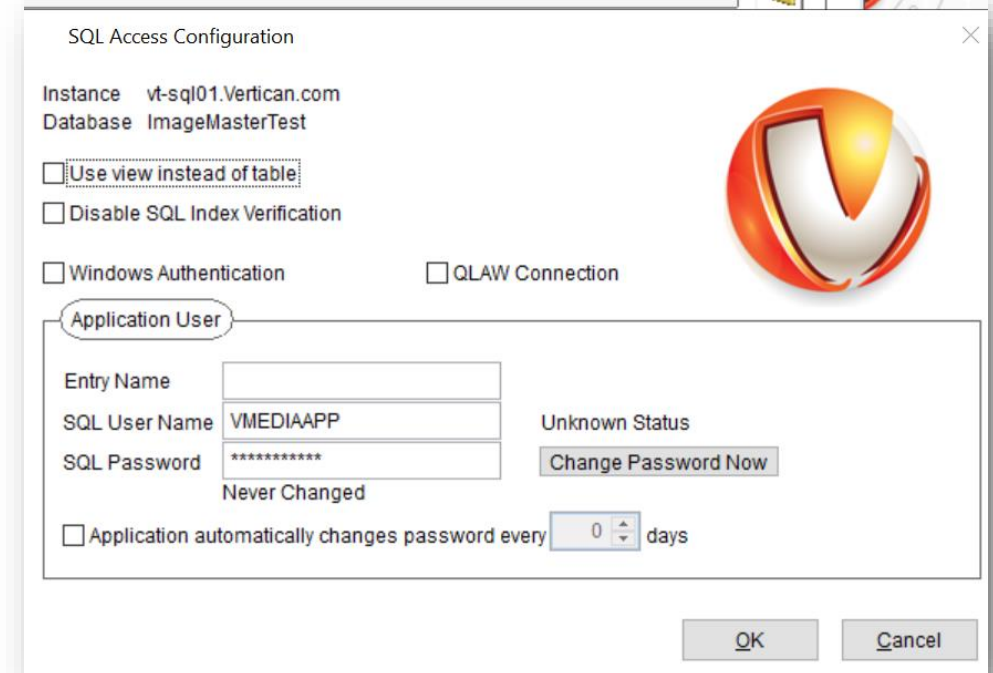

# SQL-Server Databases

- DB Configuration
  - Global Settings
  - SQL-Server Options
- Disable SQL Index Verification
  - Buyer beware, you own the indexes!
- Windows Authentication
  - New Application User
  - End users no longer need to have their own SQL-Server Rights
  - Automatic password changes (No one, even the admin knows the password!)
    - DSNX – Encrypted DSN Entry!





# SQL-Server - DBA Role

- SQL-Server Database Administrator (DBA) typically includes a wide range of responsibilities related to the management, maintenance, and optimization of SQL-Server databases. The specific duties may vary depending on the organization and the complexity of the database environment,
  - Very often your system vendor can provide services as a Part Time DBA

# DocID

- Q-LawE introduced DocID for filing media
- It's a code assigned to each document used for automation
- File & Serve, AMR, etc



# SQL-Server Tables

- `dbo.CLS000SC` (or Similar Name)
  - Table that stores the vMedia Metadata
- `dbo.UserTrack`
  - `dbo.UserTrackEvents`
  - `dbo.UserTrackLogs`
  - `dbo.UserTrackObjects` – Table that stores current activity
